Purpose and nature of event	Georgian Day is an ABC Council Signature Event held on the last Saturday of November each year. This event is craft and food and a celebration of Armagh City's Georgian architecture and heritage. The event attracted approximately 35,000 visitors in 2023. The event is a huge boost to the retailers in Armagh City Centre. The main elements will include the opening of key Georgian properties, Georgian Carriage rides, food and craft stalls, walking tours, music and festive fayre, Children's entertainment, silhouette cutter, Georgian themed workshops, lectures and talks, Shades of the Past lighting project. The spectacular light show projected onto the Georgian facade of Armagh City Library will run on Friday 29 <sup>th</sup> November and again on Saturday 30 <sup>th</sup> November. It is anticipated that retailers will open late on both evenings. We will have stalls both on the Mall and in the City Centre – Scotch Street, Thomas Street, Market Street, Upper English Street and Russell Street. The management and safety of the crowds attending the events will require the closing of streets

Notice of Proposed Special Event**

Armagh City Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council has received an application from the Events team at Armagh City, Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council that it wishes to hold Georgian Day on Ogle Street, Thomas Street, Scotch Street, Market Street, Castle Street, Upper English Street, Russell Street and Mall East, Armagh on Friday 29 November 2024 and Saturday 30 November 2024.

By virtue of the powers conferred on it by Article 8A of and Schedule 3A to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 the Council gives notice that it is minded to make an Order to temporarily restrict or prohibit traffic as follows on Friday 29 November 2024 and Saturday 30 November 2024.

- Castle Street closed on Friday 29 November and Saturday 30 November from 3.00pm until 9.00pm each day. Residents will be facilitated who need access during these hours. There will be no traffic allowed in the area at the top of Market Square i.e from Castle Tower Restaurant to just above the entrance to the Market Place Theatre Private Car Park.
- Market Street through to Upper English Street junction with Russell Street closed Friday 29 November from 3.00pm until Sunday 1 December at 1.00am. Some deliveries may be facilitated on request.
- Upper English Street from junction of Russell Street to entrance of St Patricks Trian/ Market Place Theatre Car Park Closed on Friday 29 November at 6.00pm until Sunday 1 December at 1.00am. Some deliveries may be facilitated on request.
