



# ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER 1997 NOTICE OF PROPOSED SPECIAL EVENT

Armagh City Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council has received an application from PIPS Hope and Support that it wishes to hold Darkness into Light on the Killylea Road, Ballycrummy Road, Navan Fort Road and Ballyhoy Road on Saturday 10 May 2025.

By virtue of the powers conferred on it by Article 8A of and Schedule 3A to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 the Council gives notice that it is minded to make an Order to temporarily restrict traffic on the Killylea Road, Ballycrummy Road, Navan Fort Road and Ballyhoy Road on Saturday 10 May 2025 between the hours of 3.00am and 6.30am.

A diversion route will be signposted via Killylea Road, Drumcoote Road, Battleford Road and Creeveroe Road.
