Sexual Consent

Sexual consent is agreeing to engage in any sexual activity with another person by choice. A person must have the freedom and capacity to make that choice, and not be in fear, forced or deceived.

- Everyone has the right to give, refuse or withdraw their consent for any sexual activity at any time.
- If there's any doubt about whether someone has given consent, assume they haven't. If they haven't consented and you still have sex with them, it is rape.
- All sexual touching without consent is a crime.
- Remember to:
 - Ⓐ Ask
 - Ⓑ Be sure
 - Ⓒ Consider waiting
